Admission to 3 year Semester-wise B.A. (Hons.)/B.Sc. (Hons.) Degree Course under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

GENERAL INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSION

1. A candidate who passed the Higher Secondary or its equivalent Examination (10+2 level) in 2019, 2018, 2017 and 2016 is eligible to apply for admission to the B.A./B.Sc (Honours) courses.
2. Candidates who passed in Vocational Stream are not eligible to apply for Honours Courses.
3. The college does not offer any 3-year General Course.
4. Following instruction issued by the University of Burdwan vide Circular No. RC/PERM/ ADM/18 dated 15.05.2019, the criteria for application at UG level (Session 2019-2020) will be:

5. Candidates who have passed (10+2) Final Examination conducted by NOS/ IGNOU/ Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya/NETAJI SUBHAS OPEN UNIVERSITY should have at least five subjects of 100 marks each including at least one language subject (English or Bengali) and three conventional subjects will be considered for admission in the 1st year if found eligible.
6. Marks secured by WBCHSE candidates in Environmental Studies which is a compulsory subject will not be counted for calculating aggregate and merit score.
7. As per the University of Burdwan vide Circular No. RC/PERM/ADM/18 dated 15.05.2019. Compulsory ENVIS will not be considered in case of calculation aggregate and merit list, but if ENVIS is Compulsory elective or Optional elective then marks will be consider for calculation both in aggregate and merit score
8. Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit. The subject wise merit list will be prepared based on 'merit score' for all categories of students.

MERIT SCORE= SUM OF BEST 4 SUBJECTS INCLUDING AT LEAST 1 LANGUAGE + (SUBJECT MARKS X 2)*

*For the following Honours subjects, which are not widely taught in most of the schools, marks of the alternative subjects as mentioned will be considered as desired subjects for merit marks calculation:

Desired Subject	Subject considered for merit marks calculation for non-taught subjects
Sociology	Sociology/ English
Psychology	Psychology/ English
Anthropology	Anthropology/ Biological Sciences
Botany	Biological Sciences
Zoology	Biological Sciences
Computer Science	Computer Science/ Mathematics

9. In case of candidates who have both the desired subject and the alternative subject, during merit point calculation the subject having the highest score will be considered as desired subject. For eg, if a candidate has both psychology and English and has scored more in English then during merit point calculation English will be considered as desired subject even when the psychology is present.
10. Candidates from science and commerce stream at 10+2 level, if they are willing to apply for any Arts subject can only apply for English, Bengali, Psychology and Sociology.
11. Candidates who are willing to apply for both B.Sc. and B.A. stream, should fill up separate forms by registering them twice.
12. Admission to any course of the college is provisional and is subject to the final approval of the University of Burdwan.
13. Anti-ragging declaration as mandated by the UGC is to be furnished online by every student and her guardian after admission.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

Reservation Policy for admission to three year (six semester) degree courses of studies shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act 2013 and Rules, 2014. Number of Reserved seats for Scheduled Caste (22%), Scheduled Tribe (6%), OBC-A & OBCB (as per Govt. norms) are shown against each Honours subject.

For Physically Challenged candidates 5% of seats are reserved in each category.
