The Government General Degree College Singur has been organised various Seminars during the Academic year of 2018-2019. The College organized mainly two kinds of seminars like Government plus other Institution Aided departmental Seminar and General Seminar involving all departments. The first Seminar of the 2018-2019, was organized by the **Department of Sociology, Government General Degree College, Singur** on **15th March, 2018** with the inauguration of the Annual Departmental **Wall Magazine** titled: ***Samaj'darpan': Volume II***. The Seminar witnessed the screening of the movie "***Charlie and the Chocolate Factory***" directed by ***Tim Burton***. The initiative was to incorporate ICT as a teaching tool to encourage critical understanding about the social setting and contemporary societal problems.

Dr. Samrat Chakraborty, scholar of Prof. Gautam Saha, working on the West Bengal Biodiversity Board sponsored project on "Status survey of Fishing Cat with special reference to their distribution and abundance in different wetland habitats of West Bengal", in collaboration with Zoological Survey of India, MoEF& CC, GoI and Nature Environment and Wildlife Society, delivered a lecture on "**Fishing Cat: Survey on Present Status**".
